



**ROYAL CANADIAN MOUNTED POLICE (RCMP)**

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH CARE AND PERIODIC HEALTH ASSESSMENTS FOR RCMP MEMBERS**

September 2013

Effective April 1, 2013, eligible Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) members receive coverage of their basic health care through their respective home province/territory health insurance plans. With the exception of basic health care services received to treat a duty related injury/illness, all basic health care claims are processed through the member's provincial/territorial health care plan.

Claims for basic health care services required to treat a duty related injury/illness are processed in accordance to the RCMP's Occupational Health Care program. Claims must be submitted to the member's divisional Occupational Health and Safety Services (OHSS) office. The RCMP will honour reasonable usual and customary fees for these services and claims submissions must include provincial/territorial health care billing codes.

Please note, claims submissions must clearly indicate that the services received were required as a result of a duty related injury/illness. These must also be accompanied by completed copy/copies of RCMP form 2135 and/or form 4056. Claims submitted without this supporting documentation will be returned to the provider. Copies of RCMP form 2135 are available through Blue Cross and the member's divisional OHSS office. Copies of RCMP form 4056 are available through the member's divisional OHSS office. The RCMP will reimburse in accordance to benefit grid amounts for the completion of these forms. Invoices should be submitted using the following benefit codes:

As well, please be advised that the RCMP uses a Periodic Health Assessment as a means to monitor fitness for duty for its members. In this regard, the RCMP would like to clarify that the tests and examinations related to Periodic Health Assessments are not included in the basic health care coverage and should not be billed to the province/territory. These claims should be billed using the benefit codes identified below and invoices should be submitted to Blue Cross for processing. Please note that some of these codes require pre-authorization (\*); therefore, please ensure you contact the appropriate divisional OHSS office to obtain pre-authorization. Please refer to the contact information of the member's OHSS Office provided with this bulletin.
